Preparing for the Exam

AAHAM certification examinations require comprehensive working knowledge of patient account management as they relate to national policies and regulations that govern revenue cycle registration, billing and collection procedures. Hands-on experience is not sufficient; candidates will need to refresh and enhance their knowledge base through independent and group study programs. Coaching sessions sponsored by some local chapters are highly recommended (see www.aaHAM.org or contact your affiliated chapter).

AAHAM provides a downloadable study outline included in the exam fee. A comprehensive Exam Study Manual is available for purchase.

About the AAHAM CCT Exam

The AAHAM CCT exam is intended to meet employers' annual compliance training requirements and to support individuals with professional compliance responsibilities.

Exam Overview

The exam is a 90 minute online proctored exam that measures basic competencies in healthcare compliance.

AAHAM CCT Exam Focus Areas

1. Knowledge of the Office of Inspector General compliance recommendations
2. The seven elements of a healthcare compliance plan
3. Agencies that oversee healthcare compliance
4. Non-compliance penalties

Exam Format

Examinees sit the exam that covers all four focus areas. Grading is immediate upon completion of the exam. All areas of the exam are graded together and the exam must be passed with a score of 70% or greater in order to earn the designation. If the score is less than 70%, a retake of the full exam is required.

Exam Retakes

Failed exams can be retaken as soon as the next exam cycle.

Exam Refunds and Postponements

AAHAM CCT applications are non-refundable, and non-transferable. There are no postponements allowed.

Re-Certification

To retain the AAHAM CCT certification designation, two options are available:

- Option One - Retake and pass the entire exam every three years.
- Option Two - Join as a national member within the calendar year you become certified in and earn continuing education units (CEUs). Members must be in good standing by January 31 of each year and earn and report thirty hours of CEUs within the three calendar years following certification. Fifteen of the CEUs must be obtained from attendance at AAHAM related educational programs. If membership and CEUs are not maintained, the designation will be revoked and can no longer be used.

Eligibility

The AAHAM CCT exam is available to anyone involved in compliance.

AAHAM membership is not required, although it is encouraged, one year of compliance experience is recommended.

Exam Frequency/Schedule

The exams are held three times a year; March, July and November.

AAHAM Certified Compliance Technician Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What are the benefits of obtaining a AAHAM CCT certification?

A: Your AAHAM CCT Certification can be used towards satisfying The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid (CMS), The Joint Commission (TJC) and Det Norske Veritas (DNV) Requirements. The AAHAM CCT Certification helps keep you in pace with the quickly changing regulatory requirements faced in our industry today. Certification also provides you with industry recognition, personal challenge and satisfaction, national recognition, professional development, individual enrichment, employer awareness, and advancement opportunity. Certification demonstrates your proficiency and a commitment to your profession. It provides

Q: What is the AAHAM CCT Technical Certification?

A: Compliance certification tests the proficiency of staff involved in healthcare compliance and helps to prepare them for the governmental regulations we face today and to prepare for upcoming changes.

Q: Who is eligible?

A: The AAHAM CCT exam is available to anyone involved in healthcare compliance. Membership in AAHAM is not a requirement, although it is encouraged. One-year employment in healthcare compliance is recommended to successfully complete the exam.

Q: What does the AAHAM CCT exam cover and how much time do I have?

A: The examination covers four focus areas: 1. Knowledge of the Office of Inspector General compliance recommendations, 2. The seven elements of a healthcare compliance plan, 3. Agencies that oversee healthcare compliance and 4. Non-compliance penalties. Each exam focus area is comprised of 80 questions. An examinee has 90 minutes to complete a full exam.

Q: Can I cancel my test date?

A: There are no postponements or refunds. Exam fees are non-transferable.

Q: When will examinees be notified if they have passed the exam?

A: Examinees will be notified immediately upon completion of the exam if they have passed or failed the exam. To pass the exam you must score a minimum of 70% correct on all four areas of the examination. Certificates will be mailed to Chapter Certification Chairs by the end of the month following the exam for presentation to passing examinees.

Q: When are the AAHAM CCT exams given?

A: The Technical exams are offered three times a year typically during the 2nd and 4th weeks of March, July, and November (exact dates, times and locations will be determined and communicated to you by your local chapter).

Q: How much does it cost for the AAHAM CCT Exam?

A: The cost for the AAHAM CCT exam is \$100.

Q: What study materials are available for the AAHAM CCT exam?

A: AAHAM offers a Exam Study Manual for \$99.00. The Study Manual is the only study manual written by AAHAM for AAHAM exams, specifically to assist you in studying for AAHAM's certification programs. The manual has a wealth of helpful information for those studying for the technical exams. The manual's chapters correspond to each focus area of the exams, with material targeted and geared towards exam questions. It features knowledge checks (practice questions) along the way to help you gauge your progress. AAHAM includes a study outline in the exam fee. Download instructions for the outline will be emailed approximately 6-7 weeks prior to the beginning of the exam period.

Q: How do I determine which chapter I am a part of?

A: You can download the Chapter Certification Chair directory from our website. Your local chapter would be the one in your state or in closest geographical area.

Q: Is there an application deadline?

A: All applications must be received by the AAHAM National Office by December 15, 2016 for the March 2017 exam period, April 17, 2017 for the July 2017 exam period, August 15, 2017 for the November 2017 exam period and December 15, 2017 for the March 2018 exam period.

Q: Once I have sent my application, how will I be notified of when and where to take my test?

A: You will be notified by your local Chapter Certification Chair, with the name of your proctor, date, time, and exam location. You will receive your exam confirmation email, with the Study Outline download instructions, 6-7 weeks prior to the scheduled exam period.

Q: By what method do you take the exam?

A: The examination is given exclusively online in a proctored environment.

Q: Can I cancel my test date?

A: There are no refunds or postponements. Exam fees are non-transferable.

Q: When will examinees be notified if they have passed the exam?

A: Examinees will know immediately if they have passed or failed the exam after they finish taking their exam. A passing examinee must have at least 70% correct on the AAHAM CCT examination.

Q: Once you are AAHAM CCT certified, what is the process for re-certification?

A: To retain the AAHAM CCT certification, there are two options available. One option is to retake and pass the entire exam every three years. The other option is to join AAHAM as a national member within the calendar year you become certified in and earn continuing education units (CEUs). Members must be in good standing by January 31 of each year and earn and report thirty hours of CEUs within the three calendar years following certification. Fifteen of the CEUs must be obtained from attendance at AAHAM related educational programs. If membership and CEUs are not maintained, the certification designation will be revoked and can no longer be used.



NATIONAL MEMBERSHIP - The fee to become a National AAHAM member is \$199. If you join between July 1st and August 31st, the dues are \$155 for the rest of the current year. If you join between September 1st and December 31st, the fee is \$240 for the rest of the current year and all of the following year.

FULL TIME STUDENT MEMBERSHIP - Students taking at least 12 credit hours per semester can join for free. You must submit proof of your full time status with this application. Student members receive the benefits of membership with the exception of voting, eligibility for professional or executive levels of certification, and cannot be a proxy for a chapter president at any national board meetings.

PART TIME STUDENT MEMBERSHIP - The part time student membership fee is \$50. If you join between July 1st and August 31st, the dues are \$35 for the rest of the calendar year. If you join between, September 1st and December 31st, dues are \$65 for the rest of the current year and all of the following year. **To qualify for the part time student membership you must currently be taking between 6-11 credit hours per semester and submit proof with this application.** Student members receive all the benefits of membership with the exception of voting, eligibility for executive and professional certification, and cannot be a proxy for a chapter president at any national board meetings.

Retired Membership - The fee for retired members is \$50. To qualify for retired membership, an individual must be a National AAHAM member who has retired from healthcare. Retired members receive all benefits of membership with the exception of voting. To see if you qualify as a retired member, please contact that National Office.
