

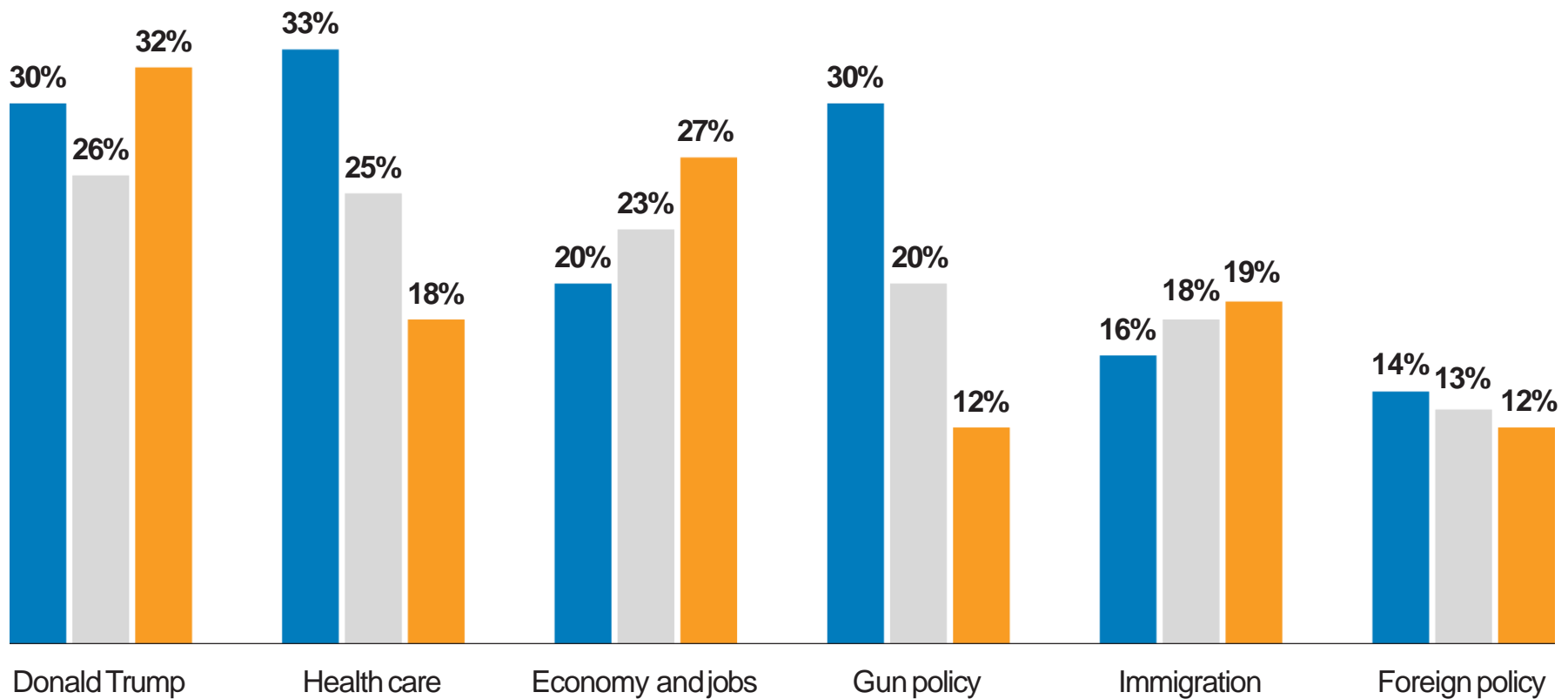
Democrats See Health Care As Top Issue for Midterms

A poll of registered voters by the Kaiser Family Foundation finds that Democrats see health care as the most important issue in the 2018 midterm election. Health care was the second most important issue among all registered voters, with a plurality of voters saying they view the midterms as a referendum on President Donald Trump.

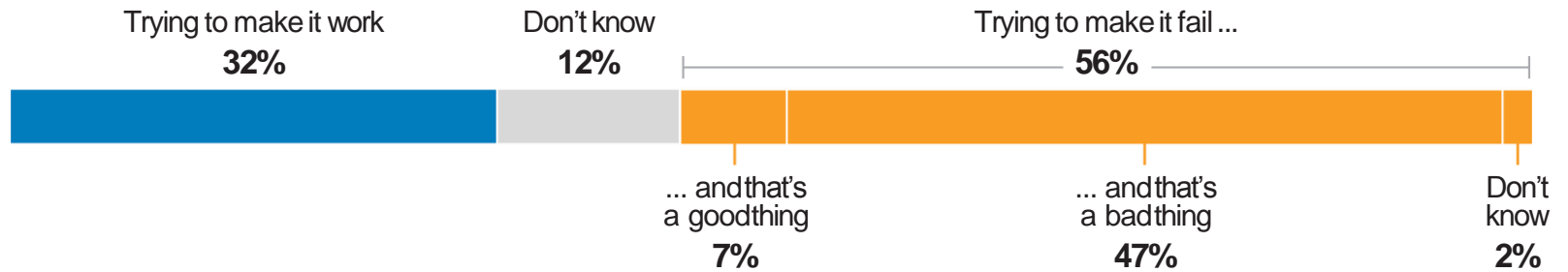
Share of registered voters saying the following is a top issue:
