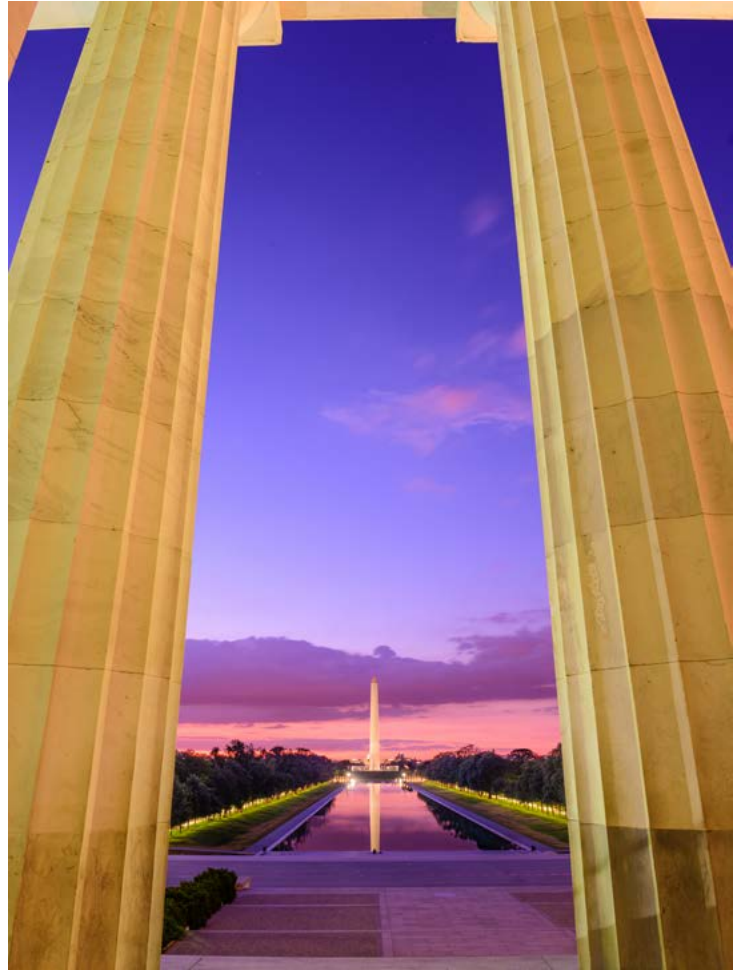
There is a lot to talk about . . .
